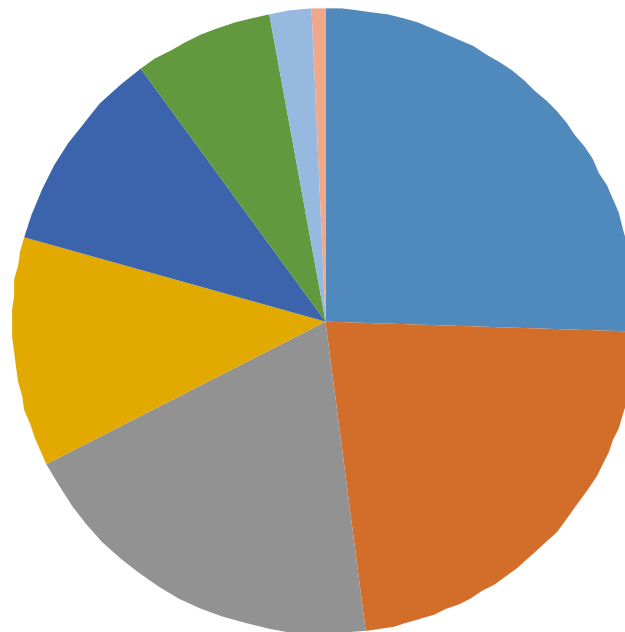

WORK PLAN

- ⇒ CONDUCT INTERVIEWS, INVENTORIES, AND A-D TESTING AT THREE UNITS (NMAI, NPG, SAAM)
- ⇒ PRIORITIZE ASSETS WITHIN UNIT COLLECTIONS BASED ON PHYSICAL RISK AND INTELLECTUAL CONTENT
- ⇒ ASSESS CURRENT PRESERVATION WORKFLOWS, CAPABILITIES, AND PRACTICES OF EACH UNIT
- ⇒ COST ANALYSIS OF PRESERVATION-LEVEL DIGITIZATION (IN-HOUSE VS. VENDOR)
- ⇒ GENERATE REPORT ON RISK OF LOSS OF AV COLLECTIONS GIVEN FOUR FUTURE SCENARIOS
